## Use EdMod to Facilitate Effective Parent-Teacher Meetings



Create reports of goals that students are working on so parents can see progress, notes, evidence, artifacts or student work that support progress, and even what data collection tools you are using to collect this data for your student.








#### Classification Overview

These include all classifications under IDEA and a wide variety under the DSM-5. They are vetted by our team and include research-based, 3rd party resources!




#### **Team Board**
